MOSES is an interfaith organization that works to promote social justice with a focus on ending mass incarceration. They focus on identifying and improving conditions in our Dane County jail and in Wisconsin prisons, while proposing alternatives to incarceration. MOSES recognizes that racial inequalities in housing, education, employment and wealth accumulation as well as racial disparities in policing, court representation, sentencing and bail have led to disproportionately high rates of imprisonment of people of color and MOSES advocates for policies that address the root causes of these inequalities.
